

**Maths** - In maths this half term, we will continue to focus on our multiplication and division skills, working with bigger numbers. We will work with numbers up to 100, understanding what each digit in a number represents. We will be focusing on time understanding the o' clock and half past.

### Geography

#### In the Countryside

This half term we will focus on learning about the countryside. We will be learning about the features of farms and how farms work. We will be looking at different farm animals and their homes. We will be learning new vocabulary such as barns, farmhouse, farm shop, pig sty, hen house, crop fields and pastures.

**Trips & Visitors:** Pets Corner – A fun day where we get to see lots of different animals and learn all about their habitats

**RE Topics include:** Dialogue and Encounter – We will be exploring the last branch which focuses on respect, understanding differences and loving neighbours. It will encourage pupils to engage with other traditions, local communities, and the basics of other religions.

**English-** This term we will focus on

- Say out loud what they are going to write
- Use the sentence by sentence process of think, say, write, check
- Re-read what they have written to themselves, in order to check that it makes sense
- Use full stops and capitals throughout a piece of writing
- Write a sequence of sentences
- Spell words with the GPCs taught so far
- Spell simple words with adjacent consonants
- Leave spaces between words
- Improve their writing by using some new vocabulary.

### Science – Living Things
